



STATE HIGHWAY 11 CLOSED

Following a large slip on the 13th of February State Highway 11 is closed to all through traffic between Paihia and Kawakawa in both directions.

The highway is likely to be closed until at least the end of March 2018. Road users should follow the detour via State Highway 10.

Access to and from the car ferry at Opuia is still possible via SH11 from Paihia.

TRAVELLING SOUTH FROM PAIHIA:

- Head north out of Paihia on Marsden Rd (SH11)
- Turn left onto Puketona Rd (SH11) at the roundabout
- Continue for 12.6km on Puketona Rd / SH11
- Turn left onto State Highway 10 at Puketona Junction
- Continue on SH 10 for 7.5km
- Turn left onto State Highway 1 at Pakaraka
- Continue on State Highway 1 for 13 km to Kawakawa
- Stay on State Highway 1 and follow signs to continue south

TRAVELLING NORTH FROM KAWAKAWA:

- Head north out of Kawakawa on State Highway 1 for 13 km
- Turn right on to State Highway 10 at Pakaraka
- Continue on SH 10 for 7.5km
- Turn right onto Puketona Rd (SH11) at Puketona Junction
- Continue for 12.6km on Puketona Rd (SH11)
- Turn right onto Marsden Road (SH11) at the Roundabout
