## Overnight motorway closures 19 December 2025 – 9 January 2026

NZ Transport Agency Waka Kotahi advises of the following closures for motorway improvements. Work delayed by bad weather will be completed at the next available date, prior to **Friday, 9 January 2026**. Please note this Traffic Bulletin is updated every Friday.
