

Overnight motorway closures 13-18 September 2026

NZ Transport Agency Waka Kotahi advises of the following closures for motorway improvements. Work delayed by bad weather will be completed at the next available date, prior to **Friday, 18 September 2026**. Please note this Traffic Bulletin is updated every Friday.
