

Overnight motorway closures 31 August – 5 September 2025

NZ Transport Agency Waka Kotahi advises of the following closures for motorway improvements. Work delayed by bad weather will be completed at the next available date, prior to **Friday, 5 September 2025**. Please note this Traffic Bulletin is updated every Friday.
