# Overnight motorway closures 28 September – 3 October 2025

NZ Transport Agency Waka Kotahi advises of the following closures for motorway improvements. Work delayed by bad weather will be completed at the next available date, prior to **Friday, 3 October 2025**. Please note this Traffic Bulletin is updated every Friday.

Unless otherwise stated, closures start at **9pm** and finish at **5am**. Traffic management may be in place before the advertised closure times for the mainline.
